Commissioners update:**NEW JAIL**

Jail is getting close to being done. Electrical work is being worked on now and being connected with the sequence of security. Opening day will hopefully be in March to allow inspections and training to be done at the new facility.

CIRCUIT COURT & PROBATION – closed for Martin Luther King

It was brought to the Commissioner's attention that the Judge had given her department and the Probation Department Martin Luther King Day off with pay. It is not listed as one of the approved holidays for the county. The Commissioners and Council members are very disappointed in the decision to do this as it goes against Handbook Policy and is unfair to the other employees.

2019 Fountain County Financial Report –

Brenda Hardy, Auditor submitted to the Commissioners on 1/6/2020 and advertised it in the Fountain County Neighbor one time as required.

Department Head Reports**Ambulance - Garth Kagels**

He reported to the council of the amount of runs that the department has run over the last year with the different types of runs and how each year the number has been going up 75-100 runs. He thinks in the near future they may have to start staffing a 4th truck to handle the load of runs that they do.

County Highway - Jason Lewis

The underground fuel tank lines didn't pass inspection so it will either need to be fixed by relining, replacing or removing the tank that has been in use since 1997. IDEM will be inspecting it every month with a cost to the county. The other way to fix the issue is to just remove the underground tank completely and issue the drivers fuel cards to use at a station. The council is leaning towards getting fuel cards and getting quotes to have the tank removed properly.

Highway Supt. - resignation

Jason Lewis has resigned as Highway Superintendent and will be starting a new job with INDOT. His last day is February 7th. Travis Covault has agreed to step up and be the interim Superintendent until someone else takes the job on full time.

Sheriff - Terry Holt

He was hoping to encumber funds from 2019 out of County General Sheriff's Budget to purchase uniforms for the new employees at the new Jail. SBOA requires an invoice dated 2019 to be able to encumber funds from the previous year. Additional Appropriation procedure will be needed if he doesn't have enough funds budgeted for 2020.

Clerk - Paula Copenhaver

The clerk's office has been given the job of sending out notices for the Circuit Court and small claims. This is a big job that requires a lot of time. They may need some additional funds for stamps and miscellaneous office supplies.

The Judge sent out notices recently without the Clerk's knowledge to collect unpaid fees which was an unnecessary expense since that is the Clerk's responsibilities and the Commissioners had recently signed an agreement with Capital Recovery to try to collect those unpaid fees.

She thanked the council for the ceiling fan that was installed in their office.

E-911 - Kathleen Osborn

She informed the council that they are accepting applications to hire again since they are shorthanded.

FLSA STANDARDS WILL BE FOLLOWED WHEN APPLICABLE

Part Time not to exceed 28 hour work week except for temporary/seasonal employees

Prior to filing any open employment position in the County, the Department Head seeking to fill the position shall notify the Auditor of the vacancy and the Department Head's intention to fill said vacancy.

The Auditor shall then promptly notify the Commissioners and the Members of the Council giving them an opportunity to provide input prior to the vacancy being filled.

OVERTIME COMPENSATION AND COMPENSATORY TIME

Each County position is designated either as EXCLUDED, EXEMPT, or NON-EXEMPT from federal and state wage and hour laws (such as the Fair Labor Standards Act [FLSA]); and employees holding such positions are treated accordingly:

Employees holding EXCLUDED positions include elected officials, their policymaking appointees, and their personal staff and legal advisors. These employees are not covered by the FLSA, and are not eligible for or entitled to receive overtime compensation or compensatory time off. The following positions within the County are considered Excluded and are not entitled to and shall not receive FLSA overtime compensation or FLSA compensatory time off:

- All Elected Officials
- Assessor's First Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-8)
- Auditor's First Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-4)
- Clerk's First Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-9)
- County Attorney
- Deputy Prosecutor
- Public Defenders
- Recorder's First Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-4)
- Sheriff's Chief Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-4)
- Sheriff's Matron (I.C. 36-8-10-5)
- Treasurer's First Deputy (I.C. 36-2-16-4)

Employees holding EXEMPT positions are excluded from specific provisions of federal and state wage and hour laws, and are not entitled to and shall not receive FLSA overtime compensation or FLSA compensatory time off. The following positions within the County are considered Exempt and are not entitled to and shall not receive FLSA overtime compensation or FLSA compensatory time off:

- Ambulance Director
- Community Corrections Director
- Highway Supervisor
- Fountain/Warren Regional Dispatch Director

Employees holding NON-EXEMPT positions, whether hourly or salaried, are entitled to overtime pay or compensatory time off under the specific provisions of federal and state laws. All positions within the County except those listed under Excluded or Exempt are considered Non-Exempt and are entitled to overtime pay or compensatory time off.

- All other County positions not designated as Excluded or Exempt


