Health Insurance - 2016 Deductible/Premium Increases

Don Hesler updated the Council on a recent meeting with Keystone and that it has been decided to raise the insurance deductible by \$500 and raise the insurance premium \$20 for families and singles. From what they can see the claims are not coming down. There are over \$2 million worth of claims. They do not foresee that number coming down anytime soon.

The clinic here in town would cost the county \$80,000 a year regardless of use from the employees. They don't think that it would be cost effective enough to sign on with them at this time. They did however add a doctor line to the insurance at a cost of \$8.00 per member. This will enable members to call 24/7 and give their symptoms to an actual doctor. If the doctor feels it is something they can treat with an antibiotic, they will call in a prescription without the member having to go to a facility.
